**By faith**, we understand that the universe has been framed by the word of God, so that what is seen has not been made out of things which are visible.

Jesus illustrated spiritual truths (**supernatural truths**) in a way that the common person could understand them. He used analogies about vineyards, sheepfolds, seeds and harvest time.

## Spiritual Truth - 4 Steps to Faith:

**Step 1: Say It**

**Step 2: Do it**

**Step 3: Receive it**

**Step 4: Tell it**

## Mark 5: 25-34

<sup>25</sup> And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

<sup>26</sup> And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,

<sup>27</sup> When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

<sup>28</sup> For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

<sup>29</sup> And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

<sup>30</sup> And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?

<sup>31</sup> And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?

<sup>32</sup> And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing.

<sup>33</sup> But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth.

<sup>34</sup> And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

Someone told her about Jesus's healing ministry. Having this information, her first step in receiving was, she said it. She confessed, verbally acknowledging her certainty of the legitimacy of the possibility. That healing was possible in Jesus.

### **Step 1: Say It**

Mark 5:28

"For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole."

The first thing she did was say it.

### **Note: Everything in life starts with a conversation**

#### **2 Sides to the Battle**

There is a God-ward side and a man-ward side to every battle, every victory, and everything else we receive from God:

- God Side – His Word on the matter. His promise.
- Our Side – align our words with God's Word on the matter. Say It!

**Negative Confession:** Speaking defeat. Speaking based solely on current facts.

The woman could have spoken negatively, and that would have been what she received. Examples: "perhaps it best for me to die", "it's no use, I have been sick to long", "all the doctors are saying it's no cure, I should just give up"

**Positive Confession:** Speaking victory. Speaking based on the truth of God's Word. Talking the promise (the answer) that God has declared.

**Example: Say It Isaiah 53:5 (If you believing God for Healing)**

But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

**We have what we say.** If we are defeated, we are defeated with our words.

Proverbs 6:2

Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth

Life and death (My conversations, My mouth)

**Proverbs 18:21**

**Amplified Bible**

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it *and* indulge it will eat its fruit *and* bear the consequences of their words.

**Step 2 Do It**

**Mark 5: 28**

**For she said, if I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.**

**Mark 5:30**

**And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, **Who touched my clothes?****

It would not have done this woman any good whatsoever to have said "If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole" without also acting upon it.

**Corresponding Actions (actions in alignment with what we say)**

Our actions either defeat us or put us over. According to our actions, we either receive or kept from receiving.

**Do what you can.**

The woman with the issue of blood said it and acted upon it. She touched His Clothes.

James 2: 26

For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

### **Step 3: Receive It**

Receiving it involves a tangible manifestation of the power of God showing up. The results of answer prayer.

Mark 5:29

And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

### **Don't be a believer, stand and become a receiver (faith and endurance)**

Hebrews 6:12

#### **Amplified Bible**

so that you will not be [spiritually] sluggish, but [will instead be] imitators of those who through faith [lean on God with absolute trust and confidence in Him and in His power] and by patient endurance [even when suffering] are [now] inheriting the promises.

### **The Order of Faith**

The feeling and the healing **followed** the saying and the acting.

Most people want the feeling and the healing first. Then have the saying and the doing afterwards.

The power of God can deliver us from anything things that binds or hurts us. Fighting the devil

### **Step 4: Tell It**

Mark 5:33

She told him all the truth

We overcome by the blood of the Lamb and our testimony

Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

The **first step** in writing our ticket is to **say it**, the **fourth step** is to **Tell it**.

There is a difference. Say it is to say what you believe. To tell it is to tell what happened.

## **David Defeats the giant (4 Steps of Faith Illustrated)**

(Read) 1 Samuel 17:45-47, 49-50, 54

### **First, he said it:**

1 Samuel 17:46 This day will the Lord deliver thee into mine hand

### **Second David Acted upon His faith**

1 Samuel 17:49

And David put his hands in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang it, And smote the Philistines in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead, and he fell upon his face to the earth

### **Thirdly he received**

1 Samuel 17:49

And David put his hands in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang it, And smote the Philistines in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead, and he fell upon his face to the earth

### **Step Fourth: Tell It**

News of the day's great victory was published throughout the land:

1 Samuel 17:54

And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armour in his tent.
