1At last we have freedom, **for Christ has set us free!** We must always cherish this truth and firmly refuse to go back into the bondage of our past.

13Beloved ones, God has called us to live a life of freedom. But don't view this wonderful freedom as an excuse to **set up a base of operations in the natural realm**.

We can not allow the enemy to drag us back into our past.

We must identify with what Christ has done for and in us.

Entanglement- Un-Entanglement Defined

An entanglement is **a complicated or difficult relationship or situation**.

A web, mix-up, entrapment, a snare, an affair, or being confused.

Un-entanglement - To reverse the process of entanglement. Through identifying our identity in Christ.

We must move from information. Renewing our mind with the spiritual truth of who we are in Christ. (Revelation, Revealed knowledge...)

We are more than conquerors through/In Christ who strengthen us.

When we know our identity, we can move in authority. Authority is not a luxury but a necessity as we exercise and exert our authority to receive what is ours and on the behalf of others.

Acknowledgement/Accurately Knowing

[And I pray] that the participation in and sharing of your faith may produce and promote full recognition and appreciation and understanding and precise knowledge of every good [thing] that is ours in [our identification with] Christ Jesus [and unto His glory].

Identify your Identity in Christ involves:

- Recognition, acknowledgement and accurate knowledge of your identification with Christ Jesus.
- Revelation Knowledge (that the Holy Spirit reveals to you. Who you are in Christ). This more than just information. Seeing beyond situations and circumstances. Who you are, what you have, and what you can do In Christ.
- Confession (mind renewing) – Declaring with you mouth. What God’s Word declares about your new identity IN Christ.

When we walk by faith we mature in our faith)

Confession is required. Foundation of our Identification.
