Treasures in Heaven

<u>19</u> Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

Study Notes of Matthew 6: 19-21 Elliott Commentary:

Matthew 6: 21 **Where your treasure is.**--The words imply the truth, afterwards more definitely asserted, that it is impossible to "serve God and mammon" (<u>Matthew</u> <u>6:24</u>).

Men may try to persuade themselves that they will have a treasure on earth and a treasure in heaven also, but in the long-run, one or the other will assert its claim to be *the* treasure, and will claim the no longer divided allegiance of the heart.
