### **God Wants Us to Know.**

This Prayer is not For God to Do Something. But for Us for us to see. For us to receive revelation. For us to be exposed and acknowledge the Holy Spirit. To Have Faith in the Spirit of God that lives in us.

Revelation feeds your faith.

This is a spiritual thing.

### **New Level**

**God wants to take our asking and receiving to a new level...**

### **The Holy Spirit in Genesis: Ruah**

The first verse of Genesis mentions a "mighty wind sweeping over the waters sweeping over the waters" Genesis 1:1

A Hebrew term for the Spirit is Ruah. In Latin this word's is translated as, 'spiritus', which means breath...

Breath is the most immaterial reality we understand; it cannot be seen; it is intangible; it cannot be grasped by the hand; it seems to be nothing, and yet it is vitally important. Storms are defined by the force or strength of the wind.

The person who does not breathe cannot live. The difference between a living person and a dead one is that the one has breath, and latter one does not.

### **The Promise: The future reality invades our lives by the Spirit.**

#### **Taste The Presence of God**

*(Licking the bowel of the cake...has all the ingredients... however not the finish cake...)*

Thorough the Spirit we can taste God's presence and power in our lives in the present. Paul speaks of the Spirit as **the "down payment"** of our future inheritance. The Greek word sometimes rendered "down payment" here was used in ancient business documents for **the first installment**; not a mere verbal guarantee, it represented the beginning experience of what is promised. By

experiencing the Spirit, we are **experiencing a foretaste** of the glories of the coming world in God's Presence.

### **Jesus and The Order of Events:**

- Blood shed on the cross
- Raised from the dead
- Keys of death hell and the grave taken from satan
- Blood offered on the mercies seat
- Takes His position at the Right Hand of God
- Holy Spirit Sent – Pentecost

Since the day of Pentecost God has been pouring out the Spirit. The Kingdom is "already/not yet": the completion or finalized remains future, but we are already living with some of the benefits of the that future kingdom. The engagement ring "The Holy Spirit".

One of the 3 names of the Holy Spirit (Holy Spirit, Spirit of Truth, and the Paraclete)

Jesus's Teaching: John 14:17, 15:26, and 16:13

A Helper, Advocate, Encourager, and Friend who come alongside us to help us.

The Paraclete is in some aspect a replacement for Jesus, who had come alongside the disciples to help them (John 14:16)

**Power Point: R.C. Sproul describes the Holy Spirit ministry as the one who bringing strength and encouragement to God's people in their every trial.**

### Defense Attorney

In the ancient world, a paraclete was a title given to a defense attorney that a family was involved with on a permanent retainer. So that anytime a person got in trouble, they could call upon their paraclete to stand with them in the midst of the crisis.

Comforter – Latin breakdown (The A Game....)

Cum = "with"

forte = "it's strength or strong point"

Comforter is someone who comes with strength.

Jesus Promise to send a comforter to stand with you not after the battle but in the battle.

An ally to stand with us and to encourage us.

### Power Defined

The Greek word *dunamis* in the Bible generally means "power, force, or ability." refer to this boundless power of our creator God

This Greek word *dunamis* is where our English word "dynamite" and "dynamic" comes from. Paul wanted Timothy to know that God had given him the dynamite ability to stand strong in the faith and the dynamic skill to share his faith with others.
