The Power In Us

for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.

Power Defined

The Greek word *dunamis* in the Bible generally means "power, force, or ability." refer to this boundless power of our creator God

This Greek word *dunamis* is where our English word "dynamite" and "dynamic" comes from. Paul wanted Timothy to know that God had given him the dynamite ability to stand strong in the faith and the dynamic skill to share his faith with others.

Surpassing Power- That Raised Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:7 ESV

But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us.

Surpassing includes the following: Outstripping, Outdoing, Outshining, Topping (See you at the top...), Transcending, Go beyond, Do better than, Go one better than, to follow, Better, Outstanding, Superior,

Power to change:

Confirmation of the Holy Spirit power at work in us is the power to help bring change to our character.

22 But the fruit of the [Holy] Spirit [the work which His presence within accomplishes] is love, joy (gladness), peace, patience (an even temper, forbearance), kindness, goodness (benevolence), faithfulness,

23 Gentleness (meekness, humility), self-control (self-restraint, continence). Against such things there is no law [that can bring a charge].

Power to Lead us to truth

The Holy Spirit supplies His Power empowering us to discern the truth.

John 16:13 AMPC

But when He, the Spirit of Truth (the Truth-giving Spirit) comes, He will guide you into all the Truth (the whole, full Truth). For He will not speak His own message [on His own authority]; but He will tell whatever He hears [from the Father; He will give the message that has been given to Him], and He will announce and declare to you the things that are to come [that will happen in the future].

Power to help us pray

When we pray with the Holy Spirit guidance. We are enabled to pray exactly what needs to be prayed.

So too the [Holy] Spirit comes to our aid and bears us up in our weakness; for we do not know what prayer to offer nor how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes to meet our supplication and pleads in our behalf with unspeakable yearnings and groanings too deep for utterance.

Power to do Ministry/Represent Christ in the Earth

Power to overcome sin

In our strength, we cannot overcome the power of sin. The good new is we don't have to. The Holy Spirit provides the strength to overcome the influence and pull of sin in our lives.
